

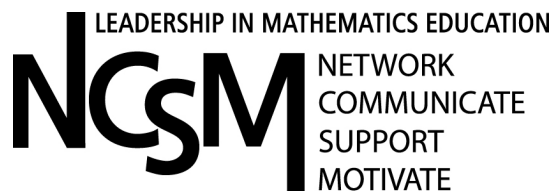

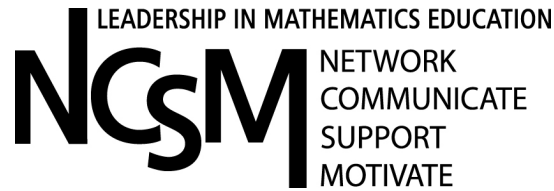

Sponsor Partnership Levels for NCSM

NCSM has received tremendous support (both in-kind and monetary) from a variety of sponsor partners over the years. These contributions play an important role in NCSM's ability to provide high-quality professional growth opportunities, services, and products to NCSM members, year in and year out. NCSM has three elite levels of sponsor partnership: Silver, Gold, and Platinum. Contribution levels and associated benefits for each elite level are found later in this summary.

Timing is important

We are eager to begin our partnership with you. Committing early (by July 15) provides the best opportunity to enjoy the most robust set of benefits.

- NCSM's fiscal year (FY) runs from July 1 through June 30.
- On July 1, your contributions for the FY begin at zero because there are no rollovers.
- On June 30, your unused benefits expire because there are no rollovers.
- It is each sponsor partner's responsibility to use their set of earned benefits before the end of the FY.

Contributions, Benefits, and Recognition

There is a close link between elite contribution levels, the timing and level of benefits earned, and when elite sponsor partners are recognized.

- Contributions you make during the FY determine benefits you earn in the next FY.
- Your contribution level and the timing of your commitment determine the benefits you earn.
- NCSM recognizes contributions you make during the same FY of your contribution.

First Timers' Two-For Bonus

When a sponsor partner reaches an elite contribution level the first time:

- The sponsor partner earns commensurate benefits during the same FY as long as they are still available.
- The sponsor partner also enjoys the full set of benefits associated with the new elite level during the next FY.

Remember, this bonus is only good the first time you reach a particular elite level.

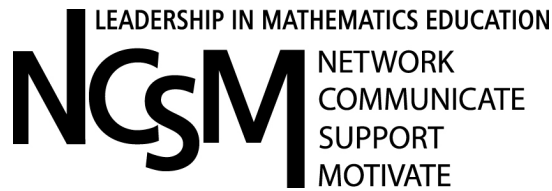
- Each sponsor partner is asked to provide the NCSM Sponsor Liaisons documentation with each contribution or at the end of each sponsored event.

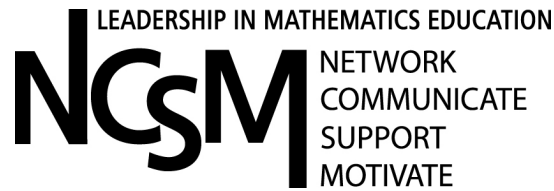
